It is very important that musicians are committed to attending all rehearsals, concerts, master classes and other KYO activities. In the event of illness or an unavoidable conflict, please inform our Secretary, Susan Williamson, by calling or texting (705) 931-0611 or emailing swilliamson23@cogeco.ca. Musicians missing more than 20% of regular rehearsals and/or dress rehearsals will need to consult with the conductor to confirm participation in the concert performance.

In order to ensure the safety of members, the parents/guardians of junior or senior orchestra members under the age of 16 are asked to escort their child(ren) into All Saints Church Hall and sign them in and out at the beginning and end of rehearsal respectively. Again for safety, both junior and senior orchestras parents of musicians under the age of 16 are asked to arrive promptly for pick up at the end of rehearsal. If musicians under the age of 16 are to make their own way home, or will be picked up by another individual not listed on the musician registration form, the Orchestra parent representative must be notified.

With respect to inclement weather and cancelling rehearsals, a decision will be made by the KYO conductor and President by 10 a.m. Sunday morning for senior orchestra rehearsal and by the JKYO conductor and President by noon Wednesday for junior orchestra rehearsal. We will attempt to establish a text-tree in addition to a broadcast email to all musicians and families to get word out.

Music folders that are on loan must be returned at the end of the concert season in good condition. Folders must be returned no later than May 5, 2019 or the \$25.00 deposit will be retained.

Where financially possible we expect parents and musicians to volunteer in whatever way they can. These might include volunteering your time to help run the orchestra, assisting with KYO activities and fundraising by donating, selling and purchasing products and/or making a personal tax deductible donation.

I understand that in the event my child is unable to continue with the KYO, I will inform the conductor and send written notification by email to the KYO President at info@thekyo.org. Fees will be payable for the remainder of the month in which the KYO receives written notification and any remaining cheques will be returned and/or a refund will be issued for the remaining months.
