The Kawartha Youth Orchestra is pleased to acknowledge the support of the Ontario Trillium Foundation through a 2018 SEED Grant to fund our feasibility study for an After-School Music Program for Kids in Peterborough. The objective of the study is to assess feasibility to start and maintain a fully-funded, child-centred after-school social program that builds social and emotional strength and resiliency through music for lower income inner city children aged six to ten years old.

Inspired by the significant successes of similar programs in Ontario and across Canada, the KYO wishes to fill a significant gap in high quality after-school programs for children living on the margins in our city. In particular, music education in ensemble settings is a proven catalyst for the development of strong emotional and social skills including keeping children involved in learning, and improving their academic performance in the school setting by learning focus, discipline, respect, and cooperation.
