2020-2021 Kawartha Youth Orchestra (KYO) Registration for a Unique Season

As we look ahead to the 2020-2021 season, we know it will be different compared to past seasons. While the form remains uncertain, we are committed to offering a rich music experience for all our members. Since our move online due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we have been actively planning for next year. All programming decisions made are, and will be, based upon Public Health guidance and will be respectful of individual family circumstances¹. We are budgeting and programming for 3 musical experiences:

1. Fully online: in the event that meeting in person is not approved by Public Health officials;
2. Blended online/in person - multiple, highly flexible and responsive models, including but not limited to:
 - a. Online orchestra, sectional and concerts (similar, but improved from this year’s experience) until such time as we reconvene in person,
 - b. Small group, in-person ensemble work when social distancing allows, with online orchestra and concerts (i.e., ensembles filmed together and digitally shared),
 - c. Full in-person rehearsals and concerts, respectful of social distancing guidelines for musicians, with online concerts,
3. A typical, in-person season (though this is not anticipated to occur).

Fees: Our fees and bursary structure remain the same as last season. While we save money on venue rental for concerts and rehearsals, the hardware and software, necessary to make the online experience a positive one, are costly. We are investigating a different online platform designed for musicians and looking at other technology support for our musicians and staff. Additionally, we anticipate that we will receive increased requests for bursaries, and increased competition for grants and other funding due to the pandemic.

Please register now: this will help us more effectively plan for the fall; registration drives our music selection, our hiring, and our purchasing. We recognize that this is a very uncertain time and are respectful of that. There are several options detailed below which will support your early registration, please select the appropriate choice for your musician:

COVID19 Safety Protocols:

- All musicians and families agree to follow the protocols set by the Federal, Provincial and Municipal Governments in conjunction with their local health departments with regard to COVID19 and social distancing
- Additionally, musicians and families agree to comply with safety protocols as outlined by the Kawartha Youth Orchestra, put in place to specifically deal with COVID19 as it applies the safety of musicians in rehearsal or performance.

Attendance – Musicians must be committed to attending all rehearsals (in-person and on-line), concerts, master classes and other KYO activities:

- In the event of illness or an unavoidable conflict, please inform us by calling or texting (705) 927-6017 or emailing info@thekyo.org,
- Musicians missing more than 20% of rehearsals will need to consult with the conductor to confirm participation in the concert performance.

In-person rehearsals:

Safe arrival and departure:

- the parents/guardians of all orchestra members under the age of 16 are asked to escort their child(ren) into All Saints Church Hall and sign them in and out at the beginning and end of rehearsal respectively; parents are asked to arrive promptly for pickup,
- If musicians under the age of 16 are to make their own way home or will be picked up by another individual not listed on the musician registration form, the Orchestra parent representative must be notified.

Inclement weather and rehearsal cancellation:

- a decision will be made by the KYO conductor and President by 10 a.m. Sunday morning for senior orchestra rehearsal and by the JKYO conductor and President by 3 p.m. Wednesday for junior orchestra rehearsal; this will be communicated via email/text.

On-line rehearsals:

- musicians should be online in the virtual rehearsal waiting room 5 minutes prior to the start of rehearsal
- musicians should have their music, stand, and instrument and be prepared to play

Music:

- Paper copies of music must be returned to the librarian at the end of each concert and/or the season

Volunteering:

- As a registered charity, we are heavily reliant upon volunteers. Please help by: assisting with KYO activities and fundraising, by donating, selling and purchasing products and/or making a personal tax deductible donation.

Withdrawal:

- I understand that in the event my child is unable to continue with the KYO, I will inform the conductor and send written notification by email to the KYO President at info@thekyo.org. Fees will be payable for the remainder of the month in which the KYO receives written notification and any remaining cheques will be returned and/or a refund will be issued for the remaining months.
