our concert season. In Season 18, due to COVID-19 restrictions, concert performance

may be virtual or live-streamed.

Repertoire: One movement of a solo concerto or an appropriate one-movement composition with

piano accompaniment and a total performance time that does not exceed five minutes.

How: Complete the 'Intention to Audition' form and submit to Ann@thekyo.org on or before

Friday, November 6, 2020.

Audition date: Given current restrictions, in-person, live auditions will not proceed as originally

planned. Instead, musicians are asked to pre-record their audition in one take and submit it via YouTube. Recording instructions are available here. Deadline for recorded

audition submission is 12:00 noon, December 4, 2020.

Note: Should health restrictions lift so that in-person auditions become possible, an announcement will be made during regular rehearsals and new requirements will be

circulated.

Selection: Only one (1) musician will be invited by the adjudication panel to perform in concert.
